- How we treat those who are dying in our community reflects who we are as a society. Every person has a right to die in dignity, to have access to physical, psychological, bereavement and spiritual care and to be granted the respect consistent with other phases of life.
- We know that 90% of Canadians would prefer to die at home. However, 75% still die in hospital. ARCH is committed to providing the best possible quality end-of life care to palliative patients in our area and their families. On Fourth Line and Brule Road, we are building a ten-bedroom residential hospice, a home away from home for individuals who can no longer be cared for at home but do not require the high tech care of an acute care hospital or do not wish to die there.

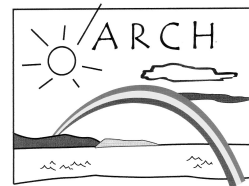
